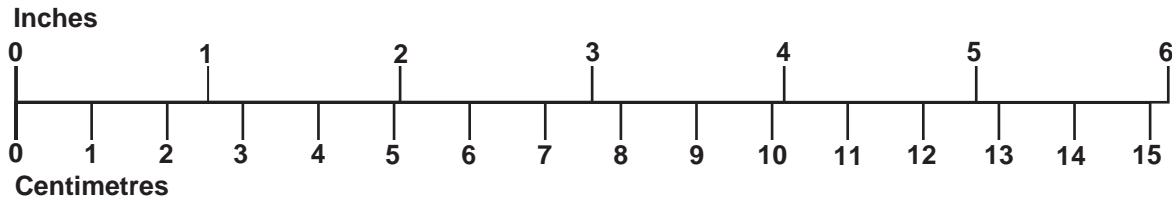


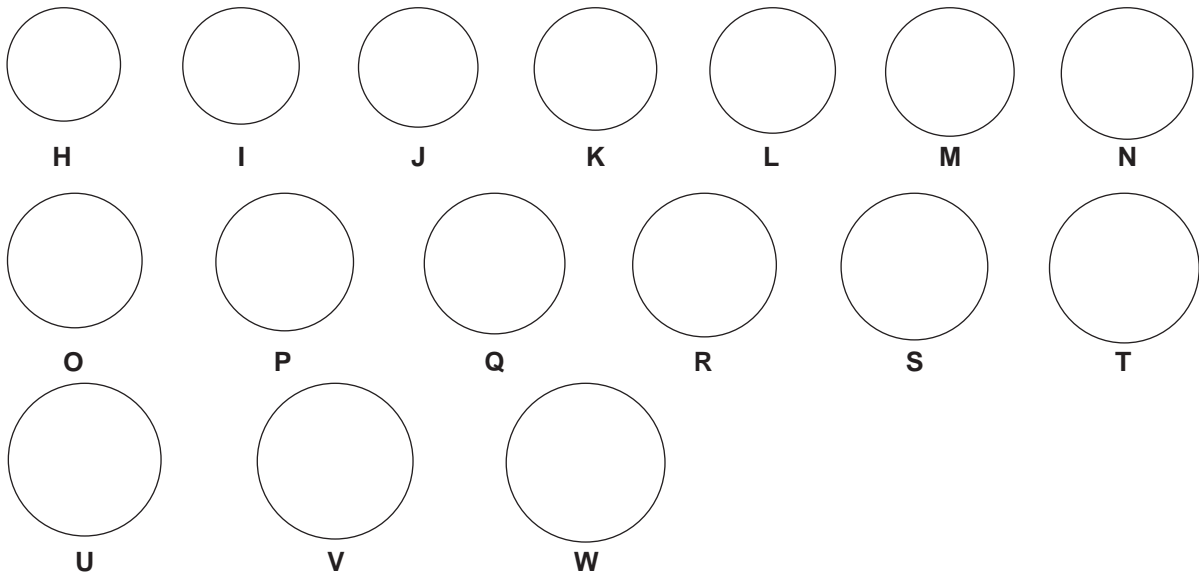
Print Size Check

Please check first that this page has printed the correct size by placing a ruler against this line and verifying the check marks. A difference of up to 0.3cm over 15cm, or 1/8 inch over 6 inches is acceptable.



Method 1:

Place your wedding band, or other flat edged ring that fits comfortably, on each of the circles below, the right size will be when the edge of the circle touches the inside of your ring all the way round.



Method 2:

Carefully cut out the strip below and wrap it around the joint of your finger, starting from the end with the arrow. The letter that corresponds with the edge of the strip when the strip is tight around the joint is your finger size.



Note:

Both of these methods are only approximate but will give a reasonably good idea of your finger size. If you are considering buying a ring with a wider band, you should choose a size up.
